Data Description:

- FADs provides a record of financial aid for each student at an institution of higher education for the academic year;
- Information is collected for each student who enrolled and completed a FAFSA or TAFSA (some students may not have received aid);
- Information includes data from financial applications (e.g., adjusted gross income, parental education/income, demographics, dependency status, residency status, enrollment time, classification, etc.);
- Data also includes aid information from the institution (e.g., cost of attendance, expected contribution, exemptions/waivers, grants, scholarships, loans, work-study, etc.);
- Aid differs according to the individual costs of attendance of the institution;
- Specific information on aid also differs by type of institution and type of aid (e.g., TEXAS Grant program, subsidized federal loans, Institution funded merit-based gift aid, academic competitive grant, etc.).
