



FROM PROPOSAL TO PRODUCT: THE PROCESS

Submit Proposal for Review by ERC Advisory Board

Onboarding & Payment

Data Access & Research

Output Review & Release

Policy Brief

- Must be of benefit to Texas. Proposal guidelines & deadline dates on ERC website.
- Board meets quarterly to review new proposals.
- Projects typically approved for two (2) years.

- Submit all required paperwork and complete necessary training.
- Submit project payment. (Fee structure on ERC website.)
- Set up remote and server access, meeting all security requirements.

- Researcher(s) create datasets and conduct analyses.
- May apply for project extension if need more time.
- Timeline maximum is five (5) years per project.
- FERPA reviews conducted for all research product output.
- Data released back to researcher.
- Due within 60 days of project end date.
- Required by state mandate to aid with dissemination of research findings.
