

Texas Credential to Career Crosswalk

Overview

This crosswalk combines publicly available data from multiple agencies, including the Texas Education Agency (TEA) and the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC), to create linked datasets that connect regional labor demand (Standard Occupational Classification [SOC] codes) to Career and Technical Education (CTE) Programs of Study (POS), Industry-Based Certifications (IBCs), and postsecondary program areas (Classification of Instructional Programs [CIP] codes). The resulting crosswalk provides an integrated view of how labor market needs align with education and credential pathways across Texas.

LWDA Labor Market Information (LMI) Reports, Texas Workforce Commission 2020–2030 projections

Regional labor market reports for each of the 28 Workforce Development Areas (WDAs) in Texas, plus a statewide summary, developed from the TexasWages database. Each report includes projected growth rates, median annual wages, and total annual openings for occupations, along with TEA-defined Career Clusters and Programs of Study aligned to each occupation.

Purpose and Context

Designed for local use in the Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment (CLNA) process to help school districts, workforce boards, and other stakeholders identify high-growth, high wage occupations and align CTE programs accordingly. Programs of Study Change Crosswalk, Texas Education Agency

Reference for changes to POS codes/titles between 2020–2024 and 2024–2025 frameworks.

Purpose and Context

Standardizes historical vs. current POS names/codes for longitudinal analysis and integration with IBC, SOC, and LMI data.

CIP-SOC Crosswalk, National Center for Education Statistics and Bureau of Labor Statistics

Federal crosswalk linking postsecondary program areas (CIP) to occupations (SOC). Used to connect SOC in workforce/LMI data to relevant CIP program areas for POS pathway analysis.

Purpose and Context

Provides standardized mapping to integrate CIP with POS/IBC and SOC/LMI components for education-to-workforce pathway analysis.
